REFEREES AND OFFICIALS

The North West Federation is proud to provide all the Match Officials for today's fixtures.

The North West Federation, which has always aimed to identify and improve those who are keen and have the potential to progress to the higher echelons of refereeing, is the next step on the pathway of development for both Liverpool & District and Manchester & District Referee Societies members. Our referees have come from a number of different backgrounds - whether talented players who have had to stop as a result of injury, or those who aspire to reach the top levels of the game but recognise that they may not do so as a player... and everything in between.

The Federation is ably led by Nigel Yates, who brings a wealth of knowledge and experience to the group, having refereed in the Premiership himself, following a lengthy and successful playing career.

Nathan Power:

Nathan's refereeing journey began 3 years ago, covering junior fixtures across a number of the local schools. Following a years experience, he progressed to covering adult fixtures, as well as many other varied assignments. Nathan was invited to the Federation at the beginning of this season and has shown good promise thus far. His focus has switched solely to refereeing from playing, after acknowledging he found greater enjoyment from his new role.

Jack Beevers:

Having started to play Rugby whilst at school, Jack quickly showed great promise across a number of positions within the backs. He represented Sale Sharks across the age grades, and found success at Caldly RUFC, where he represented the 1st XV on numerous occasions in National 2 and National 1 fixtures. Repetitive knee injuries forced Jack to retire from playing back in 2021. Having qualified as a referee a few years ago to aid his playing, Jack made the conscious decision to focus on this role earlier in this season. He quickly showed promise and was invited to join the Federation part way through this season.

Zach Jones:

Zach relocated to Liverpool for work, following the successful completion of his degree. He began his refereeing in Warwickshire 3 seasons ago and, upon relocation, was invited to the Federation. He has regularly attended training & development meetings ran by the Federation, adapting well to rugby in the North West and showcasing his ability. Zach has noticed that the rugby he is currently experiencing is of a greater standard than he is used to in Warwickshire, and it is due to the help and support he is receiving from the Federations coaches that he has adapted so easily.

Morgan Sparke:

Morgan moved from Newcastle, to attend university in Manchester, at the beginning of this season. Morgan had 2 years of prior experience as a referee before his move, and was invited to join the Federation not long after arriving in the North West. He demonstrates his passion for refereeing by attending all training & development events and keenly reviews match footage from his fixtures, which has been a real catalyst for the improvement he has shown since his move.

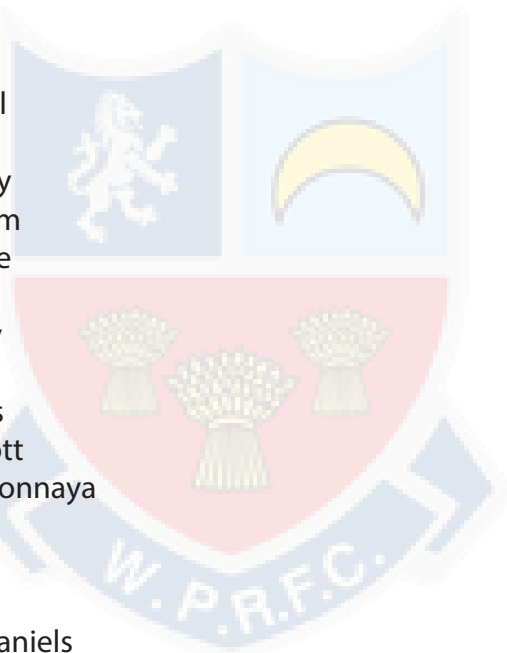
